MOST POSITIVE ACCOMPLISHMENTS:


1. Although only two new clubs were formed, seven clubs that were failing with very late submitted per-capitas were saved. At the close of my term, District 39 had 80 clubs.
2. The dues increase from \$9 to \$12 cost the district a lot of dual members. The budget had to be done in July and in January. Fortunately, we did not spend what we thought we had. The district had at least 4 district council meetings with quorums.
3. The inter-Sacramento-Reno squabbling was ended. The constitutional proposal to have division governors elected at the division level was defeated. We still use the standard International Constitution.
4. Dist. 39 Contestant, Jim Joelson, was International winner.
5. I fired an area governor for non-performance, and the District Editor for controversy. Jim Joelson's bulletin, however, remains the most beautiful that we have ever published.
6. At the Spring Contest, at the Beverly Garland, we also held a LIAR's Contest and an Introduction Contest. Contestants for the LIAR's contest were the Division 2nd place winners of the Speech Contest, and the Introduction contestants were the Division 2nd place Evaluation winners. Two sets of judges were used.
